Subject: The superiors' responsibility for crimes against the standards of international law within the European Union.

Dear head of the state,

The reason you receive the letter in your hands is in the existence of an urgent suspicion of the fact that the crime against the standards of international law, in which, probably, 200 000 victims have already died, is currently being committed in Germany, within the European Union. Provided it is true, all 28 chiefs of the states-members of the European Union will bear the overall responsibility and can fall under the criminal proceedings.

Each chief of a state as a superior member in the chain of responsibility, is obliged, when becoming aware of a crime against the standards of international law, to undertake some actions and make the decisions required pursuant to the standards of international law. In addition, please, be notified that your interstate exemption nullifies under the standards of international law. Therefore, you are to respond to the letter by all means! Otherwise, the relevant agencies will be notified about the infringement of obligation, within the superior's responsibility, to declare the crimes against the standards of international law.

In view of multiple languages used in the European Union, this attached letter to You personally is written in the English language. In addition, the evidences are enclosed in the German and French languages. Please consider that deadline for sending a response to this letter is 15. 06. 2017.
